<u>Temple Sinai Proposed Special Rules of Order</u> <u>for February 11, 2021 Special Congregational Meeting</u>

- 1. The time limit for discussion for the action item shall be 30 minutes. The 30-minute time period is inclusive of discussion with respect to the main motion and all subsidiary motions to the main motion. At the end of 30 minutes, the time limit may be extended by motion made, seconded and approved by the affirmative vote of at least 2/3 of the members present at the meeting.
- 2. The chair has the right to limit debate to two minutes per speaker.
- 3. Whenever possible, speakers shall be alternated between pro and con on a given issue.
- 4. On any issue, no speaker shall be called upon a second time until all those who have not spoken and wish to speak have an opportunity to speak.
