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Steps to Completing the StoryCorps Challenge & Due Dates:

- **Challenge 1: Due November 13th *Family Tree***
 - 6th graders need a *rough draft form* of your family tree - on November 13th, you will create an artistic masterpiece under the guidance of our art teacher, Jean Diamond.
 - You may want to use forms on our website <http://templesinaidc.org/dor-l-dor-6th-grade-family-history-project>, use one you find online or create your own
- **Challenge 2: Due December 4th *Video Excerpt of the Interview***
 - Video Tape Interview an Extended Family Member
 - Upload a 2 - 3 minute excerpt on a file sharing site such as www.youtube.com (check privacy settings, choose view with link only); send link to gpaskoff@templesinaidc.org
- **Challenge 3: On December 11th - in class: *Preparing a Story to Share***
 - Prepare the story you want to share (orally) at the Telling Our Stories display held on December 18th.
 - 1 - 2 minutes - a story that tells a piece of your family's Jewish history, prepare note cards, practice in class and at home
- **Challenge 4: Bring on December 18th - a family recipe tasting to share & a copy of the recipe for our visitors.**
- **FINAL CHALLENGE: on Sunday, December 18th@ Chanukah Extravaganza HOST your Telling Our Stories Display that includes: A Favorite Family Recipe to taste (and a copy of the recipe), your Family Tree, your video excerpt & you telling a family story.**
 - Bring parents & family members to see your display
