Blessing Before Torah Reading

Ascend bimah, stand to the right of Torah reader; touch Torah text with Tallit, Siddur or Torah Binder, kiss that object and then recite in Hebrew:

Bar'chu et Adonai ham'vo-rach!

ברכו את יי' המבורך.

(Congregation responds, then you continue:)

Baruch Adonai ham'vo-rach l'o-lam va-ed

ברוך יי' המבורך לעוֹלָם וְעַד.

Baruch Atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech

ברוך אתה יי' אלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ

ha-o-lam, a-sher ba-char banu mi-kol ha'a-
mim, v'na-tan lanu et Torah-to. Baruch

העוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר בָּחָר בְּנֵנוּ מִכָּלְ

Atah Adonai, no-tein ha-Torah.

העָמִים וַגְּתָן לְנוּ אֶת תּוֹרָתָו.

ברוך אתה יי', נותן התורה.

Praise the One to whom our praise is due!

Praised be the One to whom our praise is due, now and for ever!

We praise You, Eternal God, Sovereign of the universe: You have called us to Your service by giving us the Torah.

We praise You, O God, Giver of the Torah.

Blessing After Torah Reading

Upon completion of reading, touch Torah text with Tallit, Siddur or
Torah Binder, kiss that object and then recite in Hebrew:

Baruch Atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech

ברוך אתה יי' אלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ

ha-o-lam, a-sher na-tan la-nu Torat emet,

העוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר נִתְּן לְנוּ תּוֹרָת

v'cha-yei o-lam na-ta b'to-chei-nu.

אֶמֶת, וְחַי עַולָּם נִטְעָ בְּתוּבָנוּ.

Baruch Atah Adonai, no-tein ha-Torah.

ברוך אתה יי', נותן התורה.

We praise You, Eternal God, Sovereign of the universe, You have given us a Torah of truth, implanting within us eternal life. We praise You, O God, Giver of the Torah.
